

Catholic schools must remain accessible to all families who choose them

- Families who send their children to a Catholic school have a similar socio-economic profile to families who send their children to the local government school.
- In 2016, government schools on average received almost 16% more public funding than Catholic schools in NSW on a per student basis, with Catholic parents also contributing to their children's education through fees and fundraising.
- Catholic school families have always been willing to pay fees, but we need support from Federal and State Governments to maintain education quality and to ensure a Catholic education remains affordable for all families.
