

Catholic schools must remain accessible to all families who choose them

- Capital funding is used to build, expand or upgrade Catholic schools.
- Capital funding for Catholic schools currently comes predominantly from parents and the parish community, with some additional funds contributed through grants from Federal and State governments.
- Did you know that currently, 90% of capital funding in NSW Catholic schools is provided by parents?
- In 2016, parents funded \$316.5 million in capital projects, while government grants funded only \$34.3 million.
- Catholic school families need to be relieved of some this financial stress.

This is why Catholic schools must secure a fair share of Federal and State Government support – to maintain education quality and to ensure a Catholic education remains affordable for all families.
